

National Chung Hsing University Department of Environmental Engineering “Personal Data Provision Consent Form”

Approved by the Department Affairs Meeting on September 7, 2016

This consent form explains how the Department of Environmental Engineering at National Chung Hsing University (hereinafter referred to as "the Department") will handle the personal data collected through this form. By selecting "I agree" and signing this consent form, you indicate that you have read, understood, and agreed to all the contents of this consent form and any future modifications. If you are under 20 years old, you must have your legal guardian read, understand, and agree to all the contents and any future modifications of this consent form before you may use this service. However, if you have already accepted the service, it is considered that you have obtained the consent of your legal guardian and will abide by all the regulations below.

I. Collection, Update, and Storage of Basic Data

1. The Department collects your personal data in accordance with the “Personal Data Protection Act” of the Republic of China and relevant laws and regulations, following the university’s “Privacy Policy Statement.”
2. Please provide accurate, up-to-date, and complete personal data when applying.
3. The personal data collected by the Department for business purposes includes your student ID, name, contact information (phone), and other details.
4. If there are any changes to your personal data, please actively apply to the Department to update it to ensure that it remains accurate, current, and complete.
5. If you provide incorrect, false, outdated, incomplete, or misleading information, you will lose related rights and benefits.
6. According to the “Personal Data Protection Act” of the Republic of China, you have the following rights regarding your personal data: (1) Request to inquire or review. (2) Request a copy. (3) Request supplementation or correction. (4) Request to stop the collection, processing, and use of the data. (5) Request deletion. However, the Department may refuse these requests if they are necessary for executing duties or business. If you wish to exercise the above rights, please refer to the university’s “Privacy Policy Statement” for contact details or contact the Department. The Department will not be liable for any loss of rights resulting from your exercise of these rights.

II. Purpose of Collecting Personal Data

1. The Department collects your personal data to perform relevant tasks for the Department of Environmental Engineering at National Chung Hsing University.
2. If the manner in which your personal data is used differs from the purpose for which it was originally collected, we will seek your written consent before use. You may refuse to provide personal data to the university, but doing so may result in losing your rights.
3. The Department will use your personal data for an indefinite period, and the data will be primarily utilized in Taiwan. Some data may be applied globally depending on demand.

III. Confidentiality of Basic Data

Your personal data is protected and governed by the Department’s “Privacy Policy Statement.” If the Department violates the “Personal Data Protection Act” or if your data

is stolen, leaked, altered, or otherwise compromised due to natural disasters, accidents, or other unforeseen events, the Department will notify you through appropriate methods such as phone, letter, email, or website announcement once the issue is identified.

IV. Validity of the Consent Form

1. By selecting "I agree" and signing this consent form, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agreed to all the contents of this consent form. If you violate any of the terms below, the Department reserves the right to terminate all benefits or services provided to you.
2. The Department reserves the right to modify the regulations of this consent form at any time. When modifications occur, the Department will announce the changes on the Department's website (no individual notifications will be made). If you do not agree with the modified content, please refrain from continuing to use this service. Otherwise, you will be deemed to have agreed to and accepted the revised content and its terms.
3. Any suggestions or information obtained from this consent form, whether in written or oral form, unless clearly specified in the terms of this consent form, does not constitute any guarantee outside the terms of this consent form.

V. 5. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

The interpretation and application of this consent form, as well as any disputes related to this consent form, shall be governed by the laws of the Republic of China, and the Taichung District Court in Taiwan shall have jurisdiction.
